This Privacy Policy explains how personal data are processed in connection with the operation of the <https://softwareparks.com> website (the “Website”). It has been prepared in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable Polish law.

Purposes and legal bases

We process data necessary to provide, secure and maintain the Website on the basis of our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR). Analytical cookies are used only where consent has been granted (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR).

When you contact us by email, we process the information contained in your correspondence solely to respond to your enquiry and manage communication, relying on our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

We may also process personal data where necessary to establish, exercise or defend legal claims pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

Cookies

The Website uses cookies exclusively to support its operation, improve functionality and generate aggregated usage statistics. Please refer to the Cookie Policy for detailed information.

Recipients of data

Personal data may be shared with IT service providers and other entities supporting the operation of the Website, with competent public authorities where disclosure is required by law, and - where a sale, transfer, investment, reorganisation or other transaction concerning Software Parks is being evaluated or carried out - with potential acquirers, investors, financing providers, professional advisers and entities conducting due diligence, in each case only to the extent necessary and subject to appropriate confidentiality and data-protection safeguards.

International transfers

Where service providers, transaction participants or a purchaser process personal data outside the EEA, any transfer will be carried out only in accordance with Chapter V GDPR and with the applicable safeguards, including an adequacy decision or appropriate safeguards where required.

Retention period

Personal data are retained only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, until consent is withdrawn or a valid objection is raised where applicable, unless a longer retention period is required by law or necessary for legal claims. Profiling

Personal data are not subject to automated profiling.

Your rights

You may request access to, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability or object to the processing of your personal data in accordance with the GDPR. Consent may be withdrawn at any time by contacting IT.Consulting@dollarro.com. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland.

Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss or misuse. Access is limited to authorised persons.

Sale, transfer or reorganisation of the Software Parks business

Dollarro Sp. z o.o. may sell, transfer, contribute, assign or otherwise dispose of all or part of the Software Parks business or its assets, including the softwareparks.com domain, intellectual-property rights, systems, contracts, commercial relationships, customer and prospective-customer records, enquiries, correspondence, project documentation and other materials connected with persons or organisations that contacted or used Software Parks. Such a transaction may be carried out together with a sale of Dollarro Sp. z o.o. or its shares, or as an asset/business sale without any sale of Dollarro Sp. z o.o., and the purchaser may be a legal entity, another organisation or a natural person.

For the purpose of evaluating, negotiating, preparing and completing such a transaction, personal data may be disclosed to potential purchasers, investors, financing providers, professional advisers and due-diligence providers only insofar as

necessary. Before completion, Dollarro Sp. z o.o. will apply data minimisation, access restrictions, confidentiality obligations and other appropriate technical and organisational safeguards. Where reasonably practicable, information used for due diligence will be aggregated, redacted or pseudonymised.

The processing and disclosure of personal data in connection with such a transaction will be based on an applicable lawful basis under the GDPR and Polish law, in particular the legitimate interests pursued by Dollarro Sp. z o.o., the prospective purchaser or another transaction participant in assessing, negotiating and completing the transaction and ensuring business continuity (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR), unless another legal basis applies. If the transaction is completed, the purchaser may become an independent controller of the transferred personal data to the extent it determines the purposes and means of processing and will provide the information required by Articles 13 or 14 GDPR, as applicable.

By using the Website and voluntarily providing information to Software Parks, the user acknowledges, accepts and agrees - for the purposes of the user's relationship with Software Parks - that all or part of the Software Parks business may be sold or transferred as described above. This acceptance concerns the possibility of the business transaction itself and does not constitute, and is not relied upon as, consent under Article 6(1)(a) GDPR for processing or transferring personal data. Any processing or transfer of personal data will take place only where a valid legal basis exists and in accordance with the GDPR and applicable Polish law.
